<b>Electronic Print Fee (Per page)</b> Printing copies of any document accessed electronically at the public terminal	\$ 0.10
<b>Exemplification</b> Exemplifications require a <b>\$34.00</b> Search Fee and a <b>\$.50</b> per page Copy Fee for each document requested.	\$ 24.00
<b>Filing or Indexing</b> For filing any document that is not related to a pending case or proceeding including registering a judgment from another district.	\$ 52.00
<b>Motion for Relief from Stay</b> Fee is not charged for filing a motion for relief from a co-debtor stay or if a stipulation or consent order is tendered with the motion.	\$ 199.00

<b>Motion to Compel Abandonment</b> A party may combine a motion for relief from stay with a motion to compel the trustee to abandon property of the estate for a single fee.	\$ 199.00
Motion to <b>Redact</b> a record, per affected case	\$ 28.00
Motion for <b>Sale of Property free and clear of liens</b>	\$ 199.00
<b>Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice</b> All counsel, except those representing governmental agencies, shall pay for each special admission or whenever Pro Hac Vice admission is granted pursuant to U.S. District Court's Local Rule 83.1(b). Fees should be paid at the time of electronic filing via pay.gov	\$ 300.00
<b>Motion to Withdraw Reference</b> This fee is applicable whether the motion is in an adversary proceeding or a bankruptcy case.	\$ 199.00
<b>Notice of Removal</b> (Filed pursuant to <i>Fed. R. Bank. P. 9027(a)</i> ) If the party filer is a Chapter 7, 13 or 12 debtor, no fee is required.	\$ 350.00
<b>Notice of Appeal</b> Fee includes a \$293.00 docketing fee that must be collected at the time the notice of appeal is filed.	\$ 298.00
<b>Notice of Cross Appeal</b> Fee includes a \$293.00 docketing fee that must be collected at the time the notice of appeal is filed.	\$ 298.00
<b>Direct Appeal or Direct Cross Appeal Requesting</b>	\$ 298.00

**Registry Funds**

For management of registry funds invested through the Court Registry Investment System, (CRIS) a fee at an annual rate of 10 basis points of assets on deposit shall be assessed from interest earnings, excluding registry funds from disputed ownership interpleader cases deposited under 28 U.S.C. and held in a Court Registry Investment System Disputed Ownership Fund.

For management of funds deposited under 28 U.S.C. § 1335 and invested in a Disputed Ownership Fund through the Court Registry Investment System, a fee at an annual rate of 20 basis points of assets on deposit shall be assessed from interest earnings.

The Director of the Administrative Office has the authority to waive these fees for cause.

- All applicable fees must be paid electronically at the time of filing via pay.gov.
- For search related fees, make checks or money orders payable to: Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court.
- It is the policy of the Judicial Conference that filing fees may not be refunded.
- The Clerk's Office does not accept personal checks from debtors.
- The Clerk's Office does not accept credit cards from debtors with a pending bankruptcy case.
- The Clerk's Office does not make change. Exact change is required.
