ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RULE 7004(h)

Rule 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure requires that, with some exceptions, service on an insured depository institution (as defined in Sec. 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act) in a contested matter or adversary proceeding shall be made by certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution.

New East Bank of Fayetteville is willing, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h)(5), to waive its entitlement to service by certified mail if service is made by first class mail addressed to: New East Bank of Fayetteville, Attn: Walter G. Rogers, P.O. Box 31828, Raleigh, NC 27622.

Accordingly, upon the request of New East Bank of Fayetteville, **IT IS ORDERED** that if service on New East Bank of Fayetteville is required by certified mail pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h), that requirement may be satisfied by serving New East Bank of Fayetteville first class mail addressed to:
