JUDGMENT ENTERED ON MAR 06 2009

REGARDING OMNIBUS OBJECTIONS TO CLAIMS

This matter comes before the Court to clarify the number of omnibus objections to claims that may be presented in a single filing pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 3007(c) & (d).


Apart from, unless otherwise specifically ordered, Bankruptcy Rule 3007 provides that no more than one objection may be joined in a single pleading. To balance efficiency with due process, this Court finds it sufficient that a document that contains omnibus objections to claims for reasons other than those provided for in Bankruptcy Rule 3007(d) may contain objections to no more than seven (7) individual claims, provided that:

1. The names of the creditors whose claims are the subject of the omnibus objection are clearly listed in alphabetical order on the face of the document; and
2. The omnibus objection complies with all other provisions of Bankruptcy Rule 3007.
