TRUSTEES FROM PACER CHARGES


JUDGEMENT ENTERED ON FEB 20 2020

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina implemented the CM/ECF system on March 5, 2001. As a result, access to court records is available only through the use of a PACER account. Consistent with the March 6, 2009 Order Exempting Chapter 7 and Chapter 13 Trustees From PACER Charges (Administrative Order no. 733), the court believes that subchapter V trustees appointed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1183(a) and Chapter 12 trustees appointed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1202(a) should be exempt from PACER charges for all trustee-related use.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that all subchapter V trustees and Chapter 12 trustees serving in the Western District of North Carolina are exempt from PACER charges for all trustee-related use.
