On December 27, 2020, the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 added 11 U.S.C. § 1328(i) to the Bankruptcy Code. Section 1328(i) allows the court to consider allowing Chapter 13 debtors who have not completed their plan payments to receive a full discharge in certain situations. In order to more efficiently process motions for discharge pursuant to § 1328(i), the court has created a new local form, Local Form 8i, for debtors to file with their motions. A copy of Local Form 8i is attached to this administrative order.

THEREFORE, the court hereby adopts Local Form 8i for use in Chapter 13 cases effective immediately. Absent further order, the court will continue to use Local Form 8i until 11 U.S.C. § 1328(i) is removed from the Bankrutpcy Code.
