ORDER GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF PACER FEES

THIS MATTER is before the court upon the application and request by Edith Hotchkiss for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The court finds that Edith Hotchkiss is a professor of finance at Boston College. She is conducting research on sales of companies in Chapter 11 under Section 363 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code, in particular those that have entered an asset purchase agreement or restructuring support agreement prior to filing. Further, Professor Hotchkiss is focusing on issues related to the viability of firms upon exit from bankruptcy.

Professor Hotchkiss falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Professor Hotchkiss has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Professor Hotchkiss shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court. Professor Hotchkiss

shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- I. this fee exemption applies only to Professor Edith Hotchkiss, PACER account number 5201540, and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- II. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
- III. by accepting this exemption, Professor Edith Hotchkiss agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- IV. Professor Edith Hotchkiss is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases; and
- V. this exemption is valid through February 29, 2024.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.

It is so ORDERED.
