The Court has considered this matter and finds and concludes that the effective administration of Chapter 13 cases filed in the Western District will best be served by the adoption of a convention for the payment of the value of the secured property tax claims of North Carolina counties and municipalities in confirmed plans, as required by 11 U.S.C. Sections 511(b) and 1325(a)(5)(B)(ii) and N.C. Gen. Stat. Section 105-360(a).

Based upon the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Court's Local Rule of Practice and Procedure 3001-2 be amended to add the following provision:

(g) Rate to be Applied for Payment of Secured Property Tax Claims of North Carolina Counties and Municipalities. The prescribed interest rate to be used for the payment of the value of such claims shall be nine percent (9%) per annum; however, a debtor may propose that a different interest rate be used provided that such interest rate is conspicuously disclosed in the special terms section of the proposed plan summary with an explanation regarding the basis for the different interest rate.

This prescribed rate shall only apply to the payment of the secured property tax claims of North Carolina counties and municipalities. Different rates may be proposed for the payment of the secured property tax claims arising from other jurisdictions.

The provisions of this Order shall apply to all Chapter 13 cases filed in this District on or after the date of entry of this Order and shall apply to all pending Chapter 13 cases to the extent practicable.
