ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION OF CLERK OF BANKRUPTCY COURT

By a separate Order, effective January 1, 1991, the present Bankruptcy Clerk for this District has been appointed Chapter 13 Standing Trustee, thus creating a vacancy in his present position of Bankruptcy Court Clerk. - 2. Notice of the position will be published in <u>The Charlotte Observer</u> and posted in the offices referred to in the paragraph above;
- 3. Application forms for the position will be made available from the Office of the Bankruptcy Clerk or by contacting Linda G. Anderton, Chief Deputy Clerk, at (704) 371-6103;
- 4. Application for the position shall be only by submission of the appropriate printed form Application to the Office of the Bankruptcy Clerk, P.O. Box 37151, Charlotte, North Carolina 28237-7151, by 4:30 p.m. EST December 7, 1990;

5. Following the close of the application period the court will make the selection for the position.
