The Court having considered this matter and it appearing that procedures should be established to provide for the disposition of plan funds held by the Chapter 13 trustees upon the conversion or dismissal of Chapter 13 cases, and, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Cases dismissed prior to confirmation Upon receipt of notice of the dismissal of a Chapter 13 case prior to the confirmation of the debtor's plan, the trustee shall refund any undisbursed plan payments to the debtor, as set forth in 11 USC Section 1326(a)(2).
- 2. Cases converted prior to or following confirmation Upon receipt of notice of the conversion of a Chapter 13 case either prior to or following the confirmation of the debtor's plan, the trustee shall forward any undisbursed funds to the trustee, if any, in the converted case.
- 3. Cases dismissed following confirmation Upon receipt of notice of the dismissal of a Chapter 13 case following the confirmation of the debtor's plan, the trustee shall disburse any funds then on hand pursuant to the terms of the confirmed plan. Any funds received by the trustee following receipt of notice of the dismissal of the case shall be remitted to the debtor.
