
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RULE 7004(h)

Rule 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure requires that, with some exceptions, service on an insured depository institution (as defined in Sec. 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act) in a contested matter or adversary proceeding shall be made by certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution.

Branch Banking and Trust Company is willing, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h)(5), to waive its entitlement to service by certified mail if service is made by first class mail addressed to: Branch Banking and Trust Company, Attn: Jack Hayes, Bankruptcy Department, P.O. Box 1847, Wilson, NC 27894-1847.

Accordingly, upon the request of Branch Banking and Trust Company, **IT IS ORDERED** that if service on Branch Banking and Trust Company is required by certified mail pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h), that requirement may be satisfied by serving Branch Banking and Trust Company first class mail addressed to:
