ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RULE 7004(h)

Rule 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure requires that, with some exceptions, service on an insured depository institution (as defined in Sec. 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act) in a contested matter or adversary proceeding shall be made by certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution.

Columbus National Bank is willing, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h)(5), to waive its entitlement to service by certified mail if service is made by first class mail addressed to: Columbus National Bank, Attn: Walter G. Rogers, P.O. Box 31828, Raleigh, NC 27622.
