ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING PAYMENT ADVICES PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 521(A)(1)(B)(IV)

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 521(a)(1)(B)(iv), the court finds that in all cases filed on or after October 17, 2005, copies of all payment advices or other evidence of payment received within 60 days before the date of the filing of the petition by the debtor from any employer of the debtor:

- 1. Shall not be filed with the court unless otherwise ordered;
- 2. Shall be provided to the trustee and any creditor who timely requests copies of the payment advices or other evidence of payment, at least seven days before the time of the meeting of creditors conducted pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 341. To be considered timely, a creditor's request must be received at least 15 days before the first date set for the § 341(a) meeting of creditors; and
- 3. The debtor's case will be subject to dismissal without further notice or opportunity for hearing if the debtor fails to provide the trustee with copies of payment



advices within 10 days of a request, or within such additional time that the court may determine.
