ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ADOPTING NEW PROCEDURES FOR FILING OFFICIAL FORM 6

Section 601 of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 ("BAPCPA") amended Chapter 6 of Title 28 by adding § 159, which requires the Director of the AO to compile certain statistical information on bankruptcies filed by individual debtors with primarily consumer debts filing under chapters 7, 11, and 13. Pursuant to the new statistical reporting requirements of 28 U.S.C. § 159, this administrative order establishes new procedures for filing Official Form 6, "Summary of Schedules/Statistical Summary of Certain Liabilities and Related Data (28 U.S.C. § 159)," effective February 1, 2007.

- 1. Any amendments to Schedules A, B, D, E, F, I, or J filed on or after February 1, 2007, shall also have attached both pages of an amended Official Form 6.
- 2. When converting a case to a Chapter 7 on or after February 1, 2007, if the Final Report and Schedule of Post-Petition Debts Pursuant to Rule 1019(6) (the "1019 Report") lists: (1) additional unpaid debts incurred after commencement of the pre-conversion case; (2) after-acquired property; or (3) executory contracts entered into or assumed since the filing of



the original chapter, the 1019 Report must be accompanied by both pages of an amended Official Form 6.
