This matter being brought before the Court upon the recommendation of the United States Bankruptcy Administrator, the Court finds that the Chapter 7 case of Christopher and Kay Willis, Case No. 10-50300, assigned for a first meeting of creditors pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 341 on July 16, 2012 in the Wilkesboro Division should be reassigned from James T. Ward to Wayne Sigmon.

It is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. The case of Christopher and Kay Willis, Case No. 10-50300, set for the Wilkesboro Division meeting of creditors on July 16, 2012 is reassigned from James T. Ward to Wayne Sigmon. Mr. Sigmon shall have all the rights, powers and duties of a trustee as if he were originally assigned this case and shall serve pursuant to the blanket bond heretofore approved by this Court.
2. The Clerk shall terminate James T. Ward as interim Chapter 7 trustee and docket this order or other notation in the case docket to reflect the reassignment of the case to Wayne Sigmon as interim trustee.
