ORDER GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF PACER FEES

This court recognizes that the United States Congress has given the Judicial Conference of the United States authority to impose user fees for electronic access to case information;

This court further recognizes that individual courts have the authority to waive user fees for parties that satisfy certain established criteria in order to facilitate access to the court's PACER electronic case information;


The court has reviewed the application for waiver of PACER fees for attorney Joseph W. Grier, III who was, on February 8, 2017, especially appointed as the interim Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee") in the involuntary bankruptcy case of TSI Holdings,

LLC. In order to relieve the Trustee from an unreasonable burden and hardship in carrying out his duties, the court finds good cause to exempt Joseph W. Grier, III, from payment of fees associated with his use of the PACER system in furtherance of his duties as Trustee in TSI Holdings, LLC, and any related matters, until such time as those duties are terminated or this waiver is revoked by the court.

No information, reports, documents, or other data obtained using a fee exempt PACER account will be sold for profit or otherwise exchanged or transferred for value.

It is so ORDERED.
