

**CHANGES TO THE  
MISCELLANEOUS FEE SCHEDULE  
Effective 12/1/2016**

At its September 2016 session, the Judicial Conference approved inflationary adjustments to fees on the Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule.

These changes will become effective December 1, 2016.

**Registry Funds invested through the Court Registry Investment System (CRIS)**

For management of registry funds invested through the Court Registry Investment System (CRIS) fee at an annual rate of 10 basis points of assets on deposit shall be assessed from interest earnings, excluding registry funds from disputed ownership interpleader cases deposited under 28 U.S.C. and held in a Court Registry Investment System Disputed Ownership Fund.

For management of funds deposited under 28 U.S.C. § 1335 and invested in a Disputed Ownership Fund through the Court Registry Investment System, a fee at an annual rate of 20 basis points of assets on deposit shall be assessed from interest earnings.

The Director of the Administrative Office has the authority to waive these fees for cause.
