

ORDER EXEMPTING CHAPTER 7 AND
CHAPTER 13 TRUSTEES FROM PACER CHARGES


The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina implemented the CM/ECF system on March 5, 2001. As a result, access to court records is available only through the use of a PACER account. The court believes that all Chapter 13 trustees and all Chapter 7 panel trustees should be exempt from PACER charges for all trustee-related use.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that all Chapter 13 trustees and all Chapter 7 trustees are exempt from PACER charges for all trustee-related use.
