**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURE FOR THE
DISBURSEMENT OF POST-PETITION CONDUIT MORTGAGE PAYMENTS**


Pursuant to the court's June 26, 2009, Administrative Order Establishing Procedure for the Disbursement of Postpetition Conduit Mortgage Payments to be Effective July 1, 2009 (the "June 26, 2009, Administrative Order"), Real Property Creditors are required to attach to their Proofs of Claim a fully executed Local Form 14 ("Addendum to Chapter 13 Proof of Claim for Real Property Creditor"). In addition, Real Property Creditors must file with the court and serve on the debtor and the attorney for the debtor a copy of Local Form 15 ("Notice of Payment and/or Escrow Change; Notice of Cost Advance") at least thirty days prior to the effective date of any resulting change in the Conduit Payment amount.

If approved by the Judicial Conference, Form 10 (Attachment A), Form 10 (Supplement 1), and Form 10 (Supplement 2) will become effective December 1, 2011. These three new forms are substantively consistent with the court's Local Forms 14 and 15. Accordingly, the court has considered the matter and concludes that the court's June 26, 2009, Administrative Order should be amended to provide that upon the entry of this Order, Real Property Creditors may file Form 10 (Attachment A), Form 10 (Supplement 1), and Form 10 (Supplement 2) in lieu of the court's Local Forms 14 and 15. However, the prescribed notice periods in the June 26, 2009, remain applicable until December 1, 2011. Finally, effective December 1, 2011, Real Property Creditors will be required to file the above-referenced Official Forms pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 3001 and 3002.1.
