

## **STATUTORY INCREASE IN CHAPTER 11 QUARTERLY FEES**

**EFFECTIVE JANUARY 01, 2008**

The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2008 (Pub. L. No. 110-161, December 26, 2007) contains a provision requested by the Department of Justice that increased the quarterly fees on disbursements paid by Chapter 11 debtors. The new Chapter 11 Quarterly fee schedule is attached.

The new fees went into effect on January 1, 2008, accrue to all Chapter 11 cases pending as of January 1, 2008, and are first due from all Chapter 11 debtors to the Bankruptcy Administrators for deposit into the judiciary's account by the end of April, 2008.

Bankruptcy Form B200, *Required List, Schedules, Statements, and Fees*, has been revised to incorporate the new quarterly fees. The revised form is posted on the U. S. Court's website at:
