- 3. Exceptions:
 - a. <u>Lengthy hearings</u>. If a hearing will require more than 30 minutes, the parties should confer with one another and then contact chambers (704-350-7575) in advance of the scheduled hearing date for the purpose of obtaining a special setting.
