ORDER GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF PACER FEES

JUDGEMENT ENTERED ON AUG 03 2020

THIS MATTER is before the Court upon the application and request by Ashvin Gandhi for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Ashvin Gandhi, an assistant professor at the University of California, Los Angeles, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Mr. Gandhi has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Mr. Gandhi shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching Chapter 11 docket reports, petitions, and final confirmed plans as indicated in his request. Mr. Gandhi shall not be exempt from the payment of fees

incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- I. this fee exemption applies only to Ashvin Gandhi, and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- II. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
- III. by accepting this exemption, Mr. Gandhi agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- IV. Mr. Gandhi is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases; and
- V. this exemption is valid until July 7, 2022.
- VI. Mr. Gandhi will conduct his searches manually and is not authorized to run a data script.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.

It is so ORDERED.
