ORDER GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF PACER FEES

THIS MATTER is before the court upon the application and request by Fabian Nagel for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts. The court finds that Mr. Nagel is a PhD student at the University of Chicago studying consumer bankruptcies. In particular, he is researching the efficacy of consumer bankruptcy audits introduced in Paragraph 603 of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act (BAPCPA) of 2005. He requires access to several hundred dockets and audit opinions submitted to bankruptcy courts. Mr. Nagel indicates that this large sample size is necessary to preserve the identity of individuals.

Mr. Nagel falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Mr. Nagel has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Mr. Nagel shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court. He shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- I. this fee exemption applies only to Fabian Nagel, PACER account number 6921364, and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- II. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
- III. by accepting this exemption, Mr. Nagel agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- IV. Fabian Nagel is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases; and
- V. this exemption is valid through December 31, 2023.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.

It is so ORDERED.
