## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RULE 7004(h)**

Rule 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure requires that, with some exceptions, service on an insured depository institution (as defined in Sec. 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act) in a contested matter or adversary proceeding shall be made by certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution.

Centura Bank is willing, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h)(5), to waive its entitlement to service by certified mail if service is made by first class mail addressed to: Centura Bank, Attn: Joyce English, Legal Department -000-901-0104, Post office Box 1220, Rocky Mount, NC 27802-1220.

Accordingly, upon the request of Centura Bank, **IT IS ORDERED** that if service on Centura Bank is required by certified mail pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h), that requirement may be satisfied by serving Centura Bank first class mail addressed to:
