
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RULE 7004(h)

Rule 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure requires that, with some exceptions, service on an insured depository institution (as defined in Sec. 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act) in a contested matter or adversary proceeding shall be made by certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution.

Standard Bank & Trust Co. is willing, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h)(5), to waive its entitlement to service by certified mail if service is made by first class mail addressed to: Standard Bank & Trust Co., Attn: Walter G. Rogers, P.O. Box 31828, Raleigh, NC 27622.

Accordingly, upon the request of Standard Bank & Trust Co., **IT IS ORDERED** that if service on Standard Bank & Trust Co. is required by certified mail pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h), that requirement may be satisfied by serving Standard Bank & Trust Co. first class mail addressed to:
