ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RULE 7004(h)

Rule 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure requires that, with some exceptions, service on an insured depository institution (as defined in Sec. 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act) in a contested matter or adversary proceeding shall be made by certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution.

United Federal Savings Bank is willing, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h)(5), to waive its entitlement to service by certified mail if service is made by first class mail addressed to: United Federal Savings Bank, Attn: Walter G. Rogers, P.O. Box 31828, Raleigh, NC 27622.

Accordingly, upon the request of United Federal Savings Bank, **IT IS ORDERED** that if service on United Federal Savings Bank is required by certified mail pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h), that requirement may be satisfied by serving United Federal Savings Bank first class mail addressed to:
