
**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING RULE 7004(h)**

Rule 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure requires that, with some exceptions, service on an insured depository institution (as defined in Sec. 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act) in a contested matter or adversary proceeding shall be made by certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution.

Guaranty State Bank is willing, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h)(5), to waive its entitlement to service by certified mail if service is made by first class mail addressed to: Guaranty State Bank, Attn: Walter G. Rogers, P.O. Box 31828, Raleigh, NC 27622.

Accordingly, upon the request of Guaranty State Bank, **IT IS ORDERED** that if service on Guaranty State Bank is required by certified mail pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(h), that requirement may be satisfied by serving Guaranty State Bank first class mail addressed to:
