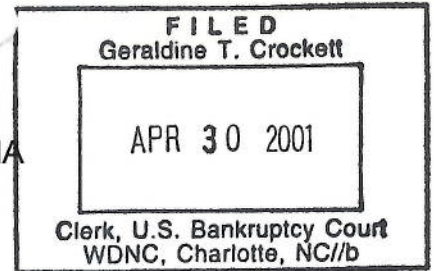

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING STORAGE AND
MAINTENANCE OF CANCELLED CHECKS AND BANK STATEMENTS**

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina implemented the CM/ECF system (Case Management/Electronic Case Filing) on March 5, 2001. As a result, the Court will no longer be maintaining and storing cancelled checks and bank statements provided by the trustee for the estate in connection with the 3011 report.

The Bankruptcy Administrator shall certify the 3011 Report filed by the trustee, review the cancelled checks and bank statements provided by the trustee and determine that all funds have been properly disbursed.

It is therefore ORDERED that upon certification of the 3011 Report all cancelled checks and bank statements will be returned to the trustee for storage. The storage period will be five years, unless applicable law, rule or regulations require a longer period.

So ORDERED.
