It is the Standing Order of this Court that effective September 1, 1988, the Bankruptcy Administrator for the Western District of North Carolina shall be served with the documents listed herein and that such service shall be certified to the Court. The address for service is: United States Bankruptcy Administrator for the Western District of North Carolina, 402 W. Trade Street, Suite 110, Charlotte, NC 28202-1627.

Documents to be served upon the Bankruptcy Administrator shall include all pleadings and other documents filed with this Court in proceedings under Chapters 7, 11 and 12 of Title 11, United States Code, and all applications for compensation in proceedings under Chapter 13 of Title 11, United States Code. Documents to be served shall also include any filed documents pertaining to adversary proceedings and appeals in proceedings under Chapters 7, 11 and 12 of Title 11, United States Code.

It is the further Order of this Court that an additional copy of each petition (including all schedules, statements and supporting documents) be filed with the Court such that the following requirements are met in both voluntary and involuntary cases.

Chapter 7	Original plus two copies
Chapter 11 (Business)	Original plus four copies
Chapter 11 (Non Business)	Original plus three copies
Chapter 12	Original plus three copies
Chapter 13	Original plus three copies

It is further Ordered that this Order shall be supplanted by this Court's subsequent adoption of a local rule regulating service upon the Bankruptcy Administrator and filing of petitions.
