ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
REGARDING CREDIT COUNSELING PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 109(H)

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §109(h), the court's Local Rule 9013-1(e) is hereby amended to allow (1) Motions for exemption from credit counseling; and (2) Declarations of exemption from credit counseling to be noticed by the use of "no protest" notices.


Additionally, Local Rule 9013-1(f) is hereby amended to include motions to extend time to obtain credit counseling as motions that may be filed with the court on an *ex parte* basis.
