## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF NOTICE OF PREFERRED ADDRESSES UNDER 11 U.S.C. § 342(E) AND (F) AND NATIONAL CREDITOR REGISTER SERVICE

- An entity and a notice provider may agree that when the notice provider is directed by the court to give notice to that entity, the notice provider shall give notice to the entity in the manner agreed to and at the address or addresses the entity supplies to the notice provider. That address is conclusively presumed to be a proper address for the notice. The notice provider's failure to use the supplied address does not otherwise invalidate any notice that is effective under applicable law.
- 2. The filing of a notice of preferred address pursuant to  $11\ U.S.C.\ \S\ 342(f)$  by a creditor directly with the agency or agencies that provide noticing services for the bankruptcy court will constitute the filing of such notice with the court.
- 3. Registration with the National Creditor Registrations Service must be accomplished through the agency that provides noticing services for the bankruptcy court. Forms and registration information are available at <a href="https://www.ncrsuscourts.com">www.ncrsuscourts.com</a>.
