THIS CAUSE COMING ON before the United States Bankruptcy Judges for the Western District of North Carolina upon the recommendation of the Bankruptcy Administrator for the Western District of North Carolina, the Court finds:

The Bankruptcy Administrator has recommended that the Court approve compensation for the above referenced Trustees in the amount of the highest annual rate of basic pay in effect for the Level V of the Executive Schedule and the cash value of employment benefits comparable to the employment benefits provided by the United States to individuals who are employed by the United States at the same rate of basic pay to perform similar services during the same period of time which is set annually by the government and the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.



WHEREFORE, based upon the recommendation of the Bankruptcy Administrator and upon consideration of the number of cases assigned to the Trustees, the disbursements made by the Trustees and the Trustees' abilities and performance of their respective duties,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The compensation paid from the Chapter 13 Trusteeships of Warren L. Tadlock for the Charlotte Division, Steven G. Tate for the Statesville, Wilkesboro and Shelby Divisions, and David G. Gray for the Asheville and Bryson City Divisions is hereby set yearly at the basic pay in effect for Level V of the Executive Schedule as adjusted each year by the Administrative Office of the United States Court and the federal government.
- 2. The cash value of employment benefits paid from the Chapter 13 Trusteeship on behalf of Warren L. Tadlock for the Charlotte Division, Steven G. Tate for the Statesville, Wilkesboro and Shelby Divisions, and David G. Gray for the Asheville and Bryson City Divisions is hereby set at a level comparable to those received by an employee of the United States at Level V of the Executive Schedule as adjusted each year by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts and the federal government.
- 3. The Bankruptcy Administrator shall annually provide to the Trustees the calculations of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts concerning allowable compensation and cash value of employment benefits as soon as such information is available.
- 4. This Order shall be effective as of October 1 of each year and continue in effect for each fiscal year thereafter until otherwise ordered by the Court..
- 5. This Order shall be deemed to remain effective on a continuing basis from year to year to provide to the Trustees the maximum compensation and cash value of employment benefits allowable to the Trustees as may be determined from time to time by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
