ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

This matter is before the court on defendant's Motion for Reconsideration filed April 24, 1997. The Motion was denied as being premature by Order dated April 29, 1997. Now that the court has entered the Order granting plaintiff summary judgment, the court has reconsidered defendant's Motion and finds that the Order granting summary judgment to the plaintiff should not be altered.

The court disagrees with defendant's fundamental characterization of plaintiff's adversary proceeding and, consequently, finds no merit in the arguments defendant bases them on. Further, the court finds nothing of substance raised by defendant's Motion that was not considered and decided in the court's Order granting plaintiff's Motion for summary judgment.

The court has considered defendant's Motion for Reconsideration dated April 29, 1997 and finds it to be without merit. It is therefore **ORDERED** that the previous Order of this court entered June 10, 1997, granting plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment shall be given full effect as of its date of entry.
